**Swimming & Diving...** The Colby-Sawyer men's and women's swimming and diving teams were defeated by a solid Keene State team, by scores of 159-91 and 173-88, respectively. For the Colby-Sawyer women, junior Danielle Bowen (Litchfield, N.H.) lowered her 100 breaststroke time to a season best 1:17.99. For the Colby-Sawyer men, senior John DeGray (Wethersfield, Conn.) improved his season best times in the 200 IM (2:15.73) and 100 breaststroke (1:11.29). Junior Ryan Martin (Chester, N.H.) recorded a season best time in the 500 freestyle with a mark of 5:34.30. The Chargers return to action on Saturday, November 8 when they will host Saint Michael's and Gordon beginning at 1:00 p.m.

**Men's Soccer (5-11-3, 5-5-3 TCCC)...** The Colby-Sawyer College men's soccer team clinched the 8th seed in the TCCC playoffs with an exciting 2-0 victory over Eastern Nazarene, on October 29. Senior Ryan Oldfield (Raymond, N.H.) and sophomore Doug McLaughlin (Derry, N.H.) each netted a goal. In the TCCC Quarterfinals, the Chargers faced No. 1 seed Western New England, who are also ranked 15th nationally. Despite a valiant effort, the Chargers came up short, losing 3-0. Colby-Sawyer closed out their regular season with 5-11-3 overall record and a conference record of 5-5-3, reaching the TCCC playoffs for a 14th straight season.

**Women's Soccer (8-9-2, 7-6-0 TCCC)...** The Colby-Sawyer College women's soccer team went 1-1 last week earning a trip to the TCCC Quarterfinals, but came up short against the No. 3 seed, University of New England, 1-0, on November 1. In their regular season finale, the Chargers clinched the 6th seed in the conference tournament with a 2-1 win over Eastern Nazarene, on senior Elise Kapp's (Yarmouth Port, Mass.) game winner. The goal was Kapp's team-leading 10th of the season and 37th of her outstanding career, placing her in a tie for second place on the all-time career scoring list. The trip to the conference playoffs marked the 4th straight appearance for the Chargers.

**Women's Volleyball (21-11, 8-2 TCCC)...** The Colby-Sawyer College women's volleyball team went 1-1 last week with a 3-1 loss to in-state rival Keene State and a 3-0 sweep over conference opponent Regis. Sophomore Michelle Doody (Franklin Mass.) and junior Meg White (Monroe, Conn.) had 11 and 10 kills, respectively to lead the attack. Senior Taylor Forsberg (Moultonborough, N.H.) contributed 11 digs and junior setter Genny Moore (Centerville, Mass.) finished with 29 assists. Forsberg was named TCCC Libero of the Week for her play in last weeks matches. In their regular season finale, the Chargers were able to defeat the Pride of Regis, 25-21, 25-18, 25-14. The team will now gear up for postseason play as they have earned the second seed in the tournament and will host the seventh seed, Salve Regina, on Tuesday, November 4 at 7:00 p.m. in the Hogan Sports Center.
