IMPORTANT INFORMATION FROM RESIDENTIAL EDUCATION

Dear Parents and Families.

The message below was sent to all students a few weeks ago.

Residence halls and college houses will be closed for all students at 7:00pm on Tuesday, November 26, 2019 and will not reopen until 9:00am on Sunday, December 1, 2019. Two exceptions will be considered during this break period:

Late Stay (Tuesday night only)

Students who have a travel-related issue that prohibits them from leaving by 7:00pm on Tuesday evening may submit an application for late stay housing which will provide an exception to remain in housing until 10:00am on Wednesday, November 27, 2019. To submit an application, please log in to the Residence online housing system, click the Thanksgiving 2019 application, and select the correct request category.

Recess Housing (entire break)

The college will offer Thanksgiving Recess Housing between Tuesday, November 26 and Sunday, December 1, 2019, to students who may need housing during this time. The fee for remaining in campus housing for any number of days during this period is \$100, which must be paid prior to the start of the break period. To submit an application and pay the fee, please log in to the Residence online housing system, click the Thanksgiving 2019 application, and select the correct request category. The deadline to submit an application is Monday, November 25, 2019 at noon.

The URL for the Residence online housing system is https://colby-sawyer-residence.symplicity.com.

Once your application is received and verified for eligibility, your name will be added to the appropriate list of authorized students. As a reminder, all college policies apply during this break period. Additionally, guests and the use of alcohol are not permitted during break periods, as indicated in the Temporary Housing Contract.

Please note that college services will be limited. Food services, the Baird Health & Counseling Center, the mailroom, and the H.O.P.E. Program will not be open or available. Students who remain in college housing will be responsible for providing their own meals. Some other services will be limited across the college as well. As always, Campus Safety will be staffed 24 hours per day.

Students who are not on the list of authorized residents are not permitted to visit the residence halls or college houses during the break period. If you need to access your room during break, please contact Campus Safety.
