## Spring Break Housing 2020

Residence halls will close for the spring break housing period at 7:00pm on Friday, March 6, 2020. Students may remain on campus for the break under the following conditions:

- Late Stay Students (Friday night only) who have a travel-related issue that prohibits them from leaving by 7:00pm on Friday evening must submit an application for late stay housing which will provide an exception to remain in housing until 10:00am on Saturday, March 7, 2020.
- Affiliated Spring Break Housing Students (students who are required to be on campus by a
  college department or program) will be provided with their housing dates and other
  instructions by their program leader. You should confirm that your program leader has
  submitted your name and housing dates to Residential Education.
- Voluntary Spring Break Housing Students (students who are not required to remain on campus, but choose to remain because of travel or local employment) will be assessed a housing fee of \$25 per night.

The board plan ends with dinner on Friday, March 6 and resumes with dinner on Sunday, March 15. Meals will not be available in the dining room during Spring Break; the dining room will be closed.

Please note that if you are not approved for Spring Break housing, you must not be on campus after 7:00pm on March 6, 2020 until 9:00am on March 15, 2020, otherwise you and your host may be in violation of the Temporary Housing Contract (see below) and the Code of Community Responsibility. If you must access the residence halls for any reason, you must contact Campus Safety first.

## Vacation Housing Contract Terms

- Students who are approved for recess housing may not possess, consume, or be under the influence of alcohol on campus. This includes students who are 21 years of age.
- Students who are approved for recess housing may only have other approved students visit their rooms.
- Students who are not approved for recess housing may not be on campus during this time period. Residential students who host non-approved students, even roommates, will be charged with "quest responsibility" and any other policy violations that may apply.
- The board plan is not in effect during this period.
- All students bound by the Temporary Housing Contract are expected to review and adhere to all of the policies outlined in the Code of Community Responsibility.
- Students believed to be in violation of the Code of Community Responsibility or the Temporary Housing Contract will be referred to the Office of Citizenship Education for resolution.
