Fellowship Responsibilities:

The fellowship will focus around maximizing functional status of cancer survivors through direct evaluation and education. General activities may include:

- Design and lead evidence-based exercise programs
- Evaluation of patients undergoing active treatment with a focus on prehabilitation
- Assist with providing educational opportunities for both patients and staff
- Assist in the with the preparation and administration of wellness programs/promotions including: creating, advertising, promoting, and evaluating
- Assist with ongoing research activities regarding advantages of physical activity/exercise and health promotion for cancer survivors

Ability to work independently and as part of the team.

A desire to work with older adults with a cancer diagnosis in different settings both individually and in groups is required.

Dartmouth Health will provide all orientation training required.

Dartmouth Cancer Center will provide any training or certification needed to lead programs. In order to participate in research activities the fellow will be required to complete web-based CITI training in research, ethics, and compliance training.

Tentative Fellowship Schedule:

The Dartmouth Cancer Center is open M-F 8:00 a.m. to 5:00. Much of the activity is currently delivered remotely and may continue to be at the time of fellowship. Some activities may be on site as determined by the fellow and supervising staff at the Dartmouth Hitchcock Medical Center. 15 -20 hours per week: days/hours to be mutually agreed upon.
