Fellowship Organization Information:

Colby-Sawyer is a dynamic and innovative liberal arts and sciences college located in the scenic Lake Sunapee Region of central New Hampshire.

Fellowship Responsibilities:

The graduate fellow will work alongside the full-time athletic training staff and team physician to provide athletic training coverage in a NCAA Division III intercollegiate athletic program and select club sports. The fellow will work an average of 20 hours/week during the academic year, with an increase not to exceed 40 hours during August and January camps.

- Coordinate care of student-athletes in a medical model with full-time athletic training staff and team physicians.
- Provide immediate treatment or first aid for injured student athletes during athletic events or practice.
- Make suitable arrangements for injured student athletes to get the necessary medical advice and treatment from team physician or sports medicine clinics when the extent of the injury warrants such referral.
- Determine techniques for the adequate protection of athletes required for participation in either athletic events or practices.
- Administer the proper rehabilitative therapy or post-injury care for athletes, utilizing available devices and facilities.
- Assist in maintenance in integrity of sports medicine clinic, including assistance in administrative tasks of purchasing of equipment and supplies, budget preparation, inventories, and general maintenance issues.
- Establish and maintain records of all injuries, evaluations, doctor's reports, treatments, taping, and rehabilitative treatment given to anyone in the training room.
- Demonstrate a service-focused and solution-oriented approach in working with student-athletes, coaches and colleagues.
- Communicate with physicians and coaching staff regarding the injury and health status of student-athletes.
- Fulfill medical care responsibilities for assigned student-athletes per the sports medicine standard operating policies and procedures.
- Responsible for other duties as assigned by supervisor.

Qualifications/Pre-requisites:

- Board of Certification (BOC) Certified
- Have or be eligible for New Hampshire state licensure upon applying to Colby-Sawyer Master's in Exercise Science program
- Ability to work a flexible schedule, including evenings, weekends, and holidays.
- Ability to carry 50 lbs in excess of 100 yards.

Tentative Fellowship Schedule & Compensation (If Applicable):

The fellow will work one week prior to the return of fall athletes (August 2023) through one week past the May 2024 graduation for the traditional undergraduate population.
