PROOF OF INSURANCE REQUIRED BY JULY 1, 2008

Dear Student and Parents,

Starting fall of 2008 all full time matriculated students will be required to have health insurance as a condition of enrollment. Colby-Sawyer College recognizes the importance of staying healthy during your college years. We also recognize that without health insurance; health care can be a very expensive endeavor. For students who do not have coverage through a family plan, or for those who have insurance plans that do not offer sufficient coverage, we are pleased to sponsor a Supplemental Health Insurance plan through The Richard Horan Agency, and underwritten by Commercial Travelers Mutual Insurance Company. We suggest that you review your current health insurance plan for allowable benefits in the New London, New Hampshire area to make sure that there is no geographic location, limited provider networks, specific illness, or other restrictions, such as referrals to off campus specialists by Baird Health and Counseling staff.

Students who already have health insurance may waive participation in the Colby-Sawyer's Supplemental Health Insurance. You must complete and return the Health Insurance Waiver Form by July 1, 2008. Students who do not provide the college with proof of insurance by July 1, 2008 will be billed for the supplemental health insurance at a cost of \$396. You may waive out of this coverage by completing the Health Insurance Waiver Form enclosed. REFUNDS are not available after July 1, 2008.

All International Students are required to purchase our supplemental insurance. You may not waive out of this program.

The effective date of the Colby-Sawyer insurance coverage is September 1, 2008 through September 1, 2009. A brochure explaining insurance benefits is enclosed for your review. Brochures are also available through our website: www.colby-sawyer.edu.
